After breakfast this morning, we'll meet for our first discussion. Then it's off on walk on Bodmin Moor with our Blue Badge guide, Mark Camp. Our coach will take us to the starting point of the walk that Mark was set out for us. Mark has planned a nice stop for a traditional cream tea along the way.

Thursday, May 20 Looe

After breakfast this morning, we'll meet for our discussion. The rest of the day is yours to enjoy Looe. Walk down to the harbour quay when the fishing boats unload their catches and visit the Old Guildhall, dating back to the 1500s. Tonight we'll be showing the film "Wuthering Heights" at Trehaven.
