

Classical Pursuits Frequent Reader Program FAQs

What is the Frequent Reader discount?

Take 5 seminars at full price, get the sixth at 40% off. Take 10 seminars at full price, get the eleventh seminar free.

How do I register for my discounted sixth seminar or my free eleventh seminar?

Once you've registered for five seminars at full price, we'll send you a code for 40% off. Simply apply the code when you register. We'll send a separate code when you qualify for your free eleventh seminar. Codes must be used at the time of purchase; Classical Pursuits will not apply retroactive discounts.

You have seminars of different lengths, from single sessions to six weeks. Does any seminar count toward my Frequent Reader total?

Almost. Seminars that you (1) purchased by rolling over your all or part of your Toronto Pursuits 2020 deposit or (2) seminars on which you've already received any other type of discount do not count toward the Frequent Reader total.

All other seminars count toward your Frequent Reader total, regardless of length or price. To get the free eleventh seminar, at least 5 of your 10 Frequent Reader seminars must be four- or six-week seminars.

Does my discounted sixth seminar count toward my Frequent Reader total?

No, discounted seminars do not count toward the total.

Does my free eleventh seminar count toward my Frequent Reader total?

No, discounted seminars do not count toward the total.

Is there a limit to the number of times I can get a Frequent Reader discount?

There is no limit!

Do the Frequent Reader discounts expire?

No, they don't have an expiration date. Once you qualify, you can use them any time.

Can I choose any seminar for my discounted sixth seminar or my free eleventh seminar?

Yes. You can choose a seminar of any length or price.

Can I choose two shorter seminars instead of one longer seminar for my discounted sixth seminar or my free eleventh seminar?

No. The reductions on the sixth and eleventh seminars apply only to one seminar.

Can someone else use my Frequent Reader discount?

No, sorry.

Are the Frequent Reader benefits retroactive?

All online seminars Classical Pursuits has offered count toward your Frequent Reader total (minus the exceptions listed above).

If you have already registered for six, seven, eight or nine seminars at full price, your next seminar will be at 40% off. If you have already registered for 11 seminars, your 12th seminar will be free. We won't be issuing retroactive cash/credit discounts.

Suppose I register for a four-week seminar for my discounted or free seminar, but a couple of weeks later you announce a six-week seminar that I want to take? Can I switch my Frequent Reader benefit to that seminar?

No, sorry. We are working hard to get seminars up on the website as early as possible to allow you to plan, but once you register for your discounted seminar, the benefit stays with that seminar.

Do your free workshops count toward my Frequent Reader total?

No, sorry, only paid programs count.

I don't know how many seminars I've taken or if I have used my Toronto Pursuits 2020 deposit.

Do in-person Toronto Pursuits seminars count toward the Frequent Reader total?

No, but we do offer various discounts on Toronto Pursuits seminars.

Does the Frequent Reader discount count toward Classical Pursuits trips?

No, sorry, it is only for online seminars. Our travel partner Worldwide Quest does offer benefits for repeat travellers, though.

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
